

DESCRIPTION OF THE DEVICE	Askina® Calgitrol® Ag is a sterile dressing consisting of two layers: an absorbent polyurethane foam layer which provides for the absorption of wound exudate, and an ionic silver alginate matrix which provides for broad antimicrobial effectiveness and helps prevent contamination from external bacteria. In the presence of wound exudate, the silver alginate matrix helps maintain a moist wound environment conducive to natura healing conditions. The individual single peel pack is designated as a microbiologica barrier to assure the sterility of the product.

CONTRAINDICATION

Precaution: In the event of clinical infection, topical silver does not replace the need for systemic therapy or other adequate infection treatment. This medical device contains 4.81mg of propylene glycol per cm2 of dressing, which is equivalent to 0.069 mg/kg body weight/cm2. Propylene glycol may cause skin irritation. Do not use this medicine in babies less than 4 weeks old with open wounds or large areas of broken or damaged skin (such as burns) without talking to your doctor or pharmacist.

Contraindications: Askina® Calgitrol® Ag should not be used on patients with a known sensitivity to alginates or silver neither where the presence of metals is contraindicated. Askina® Calgitrol® Ag is contraindicated for ulcers resulting from certain infections or medical conditions, such as: Tuberculosis, syphilis, deep fungal infection, third degree burns. Do not use this medicine in babies less than 4 weeks old with open wounds or large areas of broken or damaged skin (such as burns) without talking to your doctor or pharmacist.
